ITINERARY

DAY 1, MARCH 08, MONDAY: ARRIVAL COLOMBO- Upon arrival in Colombo, you will be met and transferred to the hotel. Room from 12:00 noon. Colombo is the largest city in Sri Lanka and its main financial, commercial and industrial center, despite the fact that the official administrative capital and the seat of government are located 10 km (6 miles), in Sri Jayawardenepura Kotte. It is a noisy, bustling, and somewhat schizophrenic city, in which the modern skyscrapers of the center tower over raucous three-wheeled taxis, elegant executives rub shoulders with street vendors, and Buddhist monks silently beg in front of luxury shops. Accommodation at the Hotel.



DAY 2, MARCH 09, TUESDAY: COLOMBO / HABARANA- Breakfast. In the morning we pass through the commercial capital of Colombo which has long been the traditional gateway to the Orient. The largest city in Sri Lanka, it is located on the west coast and brings together all the cultures, religions and influences of foreign lands in a medley of sounds, smells and a kaleidoscope of color. The original merchants and settlers: the Arabs, the Portuguese, the Dutch and the British have left in their wake churches and monuments, names and religions, costumes and food and some of their languages that have been absorbed into the Sri Lankan discourse. Today, Colombo is a fascinating city, a happy mix of east and west, past and present, with a charm of its own. A lesser known but incredibly true fact is that Colombo has an excellent range of high quality restaurants serving food from around the world and some of the best shopping opportunities in Asia. Sri Lanka's main seaport is in Colombo and adjoins the vibrant markets and bazaars of Pettah, a local bazaar and trade area. In the afternoon, departure by road to Habarana (Approx. 185kms, 4 hours). Upon arrival transfer to the hotel. Accommodation at the Hotel.



DAY 3, MARCH 10, WEDNESDAY: HABARANA / SIGIRIYA / MINNERIYA NATIONAL PARK / HABARANA- Breakfast. In the morning visit Lion's Rock in Sigiriya - this UNESCO World Heritage Site, a spectacular rock fortress, is one of Sri Lanka's top attractions. The most impressive facts of the unique complex are the Water Gardens, the Frescoes of beautiful maidens, the Mirror Wall with ancient graffiti, the Lion platform and the 1.6-hectare Summit, which was completely covered by buildings during the period of Sigiriya's glory. . Built by King Kashyapa (477-495 AD), "Lion's Rock" is a citadel of unusual beauty that rises 200 meters from the scrub forest. The rock was the innermost fortress of the 70-hectare fortified city and the base is surrounded by a moat, a wall and extensive gardens. The world-renowned frescoes (originally 500, of which only 19 remain today) housed in a protected rock pocket accessed by a spiral staircase are painted with earth pigments on plaster. The old ladder to the top led through the mouth of a crouching lion, but today only the huge legs remain that indicate the massive proportions of the head. The remains of the beautiful royal citadel are located at the top and several caves for meditation, audience platforms and baths complete the unique site. In the afternoon Safari in Minneriya National Park which is a national park in the North Central Province of Sri Lanka. The area was designated as a national park on August 12, 1997, after being originally declared a wildlife sanctuary in 1938. The reason for declaring the area protected is to protect the Minneriya tank catchment and wildlife from the surroundings. The tank is of historical importance, as it was built by King Mahasen in the 3rd century AD. C. The park is a dry season feeding ground for the forest-dwelling elephant population in Matale, Polonnaruwa and Trincomalee districts. Together with Kaudulla and Girithale, Minneriya forms one of Sri Lanka's 70 Important Bird Areas (IBAs). Back to the hotel. Accommodation at the Hotel.



DAY 4, MARCH 11, THURSDAY: HABARANA / HIRIWADUNA / POLONNARUWA / HABARANA - Breakfast. In the morning we will start our excursion to Hiriwadunna for an authentic rural Sri Lankan experience. Disembark your vehicle and begin your field trip by bullock cart. Within 15 minutes to 30 minutes we will arrive at Lake Hiriwadunna where we get off the car and enjoy a catamaran (boat) ride on the Lake. You will sail through the lake admiring the impressive views in addition to the lake we will have views of the Sigiriya and Pidurangala rocks. By boat we will arrive at a small and typical village where we can experience the life of the Sri Lankan people. We will walk through the rice fields, orchards and we will understand the agricultural life of the people of the town. Later, enjoy a simple but delicious, authentic and traditional lunch prepared by a local family in their home using fresh vegetables from the farm. Of course, we can see the preparation of the food and later in the house there will be a small presentation of how to make a roof with coconut leaves and how to use "kulla" and "mirisgala" to separate the rice seeds from the husks and straw. . And finally, after saying goodbye to the family, we will take the boat to the other shore of the lake and enjoy a short Tuk-Tuk ride to the main road. In the afternoon departure to Polonnaruwa (Approx. 60 Kms, 1 hour and 30 minutes), This medieval city, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, rose to fame as the capital (10th-12th centuries AD) after the decline of Anuradhapura. The entire landscape of the region is marked by huge artificial reservoirs, the most famous of which is the Parakrama Samudra or the Parakrama Sea, larger than the port of Colombo. The monuments are relatively well preserved and give clear evidence of the glory of Sri Lanka's past. Highlights include the Royal Palace complex, including the Palace of the Kings and the Auditorium, the Quadrilateral with its concentration of ancient heritage, and the spectacular Gal Vihare complex of four massive images of the Buddha, cut from a single granite slab, the highlight of the Ancient Sri Lankan rock carving Some of the best examples of Hindu influence: the Shiva Temples, intricate statues of Hindu gods, fascinating Buddhist temples, Lankatilleka and Watadage, Galpotha, the lotus bath, Kiri Vihare Dagoba and the remains of a Ancient Temple of the Tooth are other impressive sights. Return to Habarana (Approx. 50 Kms, 1 Hour), Return to the hotel. Accommodation at the Hotel.



DAY 5, MARCH 12, FRIDAY: HABARANA / KANDY– Breakfast. In the morning departure to Kandy en route visiting Dambulla Cave Temple. Located in the north-central province of this UNESCO World Heritage Site dating from the 1st century BC. C., It is an incredible complex of 05 caves, used for the first time as a refuge by an ancient king who, upon regaining his throne, commissioned magnificent images carved into the living rock. Later kings made further improvements and the caves contain more than 150 images of the Buddha, of which the largest is a colossal figure spanning 15 meters. Cave inscriptions from the 2nd century BC are found. C. and on the walls there are many paintings, most of which belong to the Kandy period (early 19th century). This temple is a perfect place to see the evolution of ancient Sri Lankan art and is an important historical site due to the fusion of material from many eras. Visit a spice garden along the way to see the spices growing in their natural habitat. Learn about spices and their use in Sri Lankan cuisine. In the afternoon tour of the city of Kandy including the Temple of the Tooth and witness the traditional cultural dance show. Kandy, a charming exotic city, the Hilltop Capital and the last stronghold of the Sinhalese kings is a UNESCO World Heritage site that retains an aura of grandeur, time has not affected. Surrounded by hills, with a tranquil lake in the center, it is the site of the famous temple that enshrines the relic of the Buddha's tooth and the Royal Botanical Gardens, home to one of the best collections of orchids in the world. A cultural sanctuary where many legends, traditions and folklore are still lovingly maintained, Kandy and its satellite towns are the center of the island's cottage industry (wooden, brass and silver items), exquisite silver or gold jewelry and precious gems. of many varieties, including the best blue and stellar sapphires in the world. The highlight of the city's calendar is the Esala Perahera, when a replica of the coffin that encloses the Tooth is carried in procession during ten brilliant nights in July / August by dancers, drummers, and approximately 100 exotic-costumed elephants. Transfer to the hotel. Accommodation at the Hotel.



DAY 6, MARCH 13, SATURDAY: KANDY / NUWARA ELIYA - Breakfast. In the morning transfer to the train station for Nuwara Eliya. Enjoy a scenic train ride to Nanu Oya through tea plantations. Nuwara Eliya City Tour along with a visit to a tea plantation site. Nuwara Eliya is a city in the mountainous country of Central Province, Sri Lanka. Its name means "city in the plain (land of the table)" or "city of light". The city is the administrative capital of the Nuwara Eliya district, with a picturesque landscape and a mild climate. It is at an altitude of 1,868 m (6,128 ft) and is considered the most important place for tea production in Sri Lanka. The city is ignored by Pidurutalagala, the highest mountain in Sri Lanka. Nuwara Eliya is known for its temperate and cold climate, the coolest part of Sri Lanka. The city was founded by Samuel Baker, the discoverer of Lake Albert and the Nile explorer in 1846. Nuwara Eliya's climate lent itself to becoming the main sanctuary for British officials and planters in Ceylon. Nuwara Eliya, called Little England, was a mountain retreat in which British colonialists could immerse themselves in their past pursuits such as fox hunting, deer hunting, elephant hunting, polo, golf, and cricket. Visit a factory where the most important conversion to "made" black tea occurs. The machinery used is of very traditional British design, some up to 100 years old. The process is very handcrafted, unchanged for a century. The tour ends with a tasting of different grades of this great beer. Along with tea-infused cuisine, tea-based spa treatments, and trekking trails that wind through tea-covered hills, you can literally lose yourself in tea. Transfer to the hotel. Accommodation at the Hotel.



DAY 7, MARCH 14, SUNDAY: NUWARA ELIYA / NEGOMBO - Breakfast. Morning drive to Negombo for a relaxing beach break, sometimes referred to as "Little Rome" due to the profusion of Christian churches, this archetypal fishing village has become a major beach resort on the west coast. , north of Colombo and 15 minutes from the international airport. The wide sandy beaches and the safe sea bathing are the main attractions, as is the fish market, where the busy trade of a variety of fish, prawns and crabs takes place every morning (except Sundays) when the boats of fishing return to shore. The large traditional sailing canoes are a picturesque sight in this town that was once a trading port for the Portuguese and Dutch. Other attractions are the old Dutch fort built in 1672 now part of the Dutch prison and canal, which at that time was a supply route for the Dutch administration. Upon arrival transfer to the Hotel. Rest of the day free to enjoy the beaches. Accommodation at the Hotel.



DAY 8, MARCH 15, MONDAY: NEGOMBO / COLOMBO / MALE - Breakfast. In the morning transfer to the airport for your flight to Male, Maldives. Upon arrival, you will be given a traditional welcome and transfer to the hotel. Relax and total enjoyment on the paradisiacal beaches of The Maldives, whose archipelago consists of more than 1200 islands (just 202 islands are inhabited). It is the union of thousands of islands where the sea has infinite shades of blue and turquoise and incredible underwater ecosystems, corals, fish. PASSPORT AND VISA

All visitors to Sri Lanka and the Maldives need a passport valid up to 6 months after the date of departure from the country.

SRI LANKA

All visitors to Sri Lanka need a passport valid up to 6 months after their departure date from Sri Lanka. The Sri Lanka visa has to be applied online (before arrival in Sri Lanka) on the website www.eta.gov.lk. Information and instructions about the visa are available in Spanish on this website.

MALDIVES

To enter the Maldives no pre-arrival visa is required. A free thirty-day visa will be issued on arrival for all Nationalities, as long as the following conditions are met: You must possess a valid passport and have a valid ticket to continue the trip to the Maldives and have sufficient funds (credit card credit is enough) to cover expenses for the duration of the stay in Maldives or a confirmation of the reservation in a Resort or a hotel.

LUGGAGE

Most airlines for Colombo / Male trip offer released one piece of checked baggage per person not exceeding 20 kilos (economy class). Only one piece of hand baggage is allowed on board. The dimensions of which should not exceed 115 linear cm and the weight should not exceed 7 Kilos. Travelers are allowed to carry a laptop over a piece of carry-on luggage as hand luggage.

VACCINATION

The government of Sri Lanka and Maldives does not require any type of vaccination, other than proof of a yellow fever vaccine if you have traveled in a yellow fever area within the last six days. At the very least, most tourists take protection against hepatitis A and get booster shots. Your local health department maintains a list of recommended vaccinations for travel to your destination. Your personal physician can recommend some vaccines for your special needs.
